Comments:

The Duke of Edinburgh Award is offered in Y12. 2 students who did not achieve this did not take part in the expedition for Medical reasons so did not achieve the full award, however were certificated for the sections completed.

Home Cooking Skills offered in Y13. Students who did not achieve the L2 qualification had achieved the L1 in KS4 but are not working at a level to complete the work to a sufficient standard to be entered for Level 2. They took part in all lessons so benefitted from the practical learning.

Music, Arts Award, Creative Craft, Land Studies, Arts award and Hair and Beauty are optional subjects taken over 2 years. Students in Y13 achieve the award.

Functional Skills English and Maths are studied over 2 year courses, however some Y12 students were entered after 1 year as they were deemed to have reached the required standard and will be challenged further in Y13.

Students who are shown as 'greyed out' were not entered, either because the subject is not offered or they are only part way through the course.
